- 1. Call 911 from a cell phone or campus phone. The dispatcher will ask for the flowing information:
 - a. Name and phone number of caller
 - b. Condition of injured person (suspected cardiac arrest)
 - c. Treatment Initiation
 - d. Directions
- 2. Alert School Emergency Response Team by calling the office (Ext 2001) and requesting an all-call for Code AED
- 3. The closest AED to the location of the emergency is located in the office, also one in the bus barn.
- 4. If possible, have someone meet the arriving EMS at the closest entrance.
